 - The referee will draw lots to determine the ranking if there are 2 or more players with the same ranking points

Tournament Regulations (Conditions of Play)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. This tournament will be run in accordance with, but not limited to, the Badminton World Federation (BWF) Statues and General Competition Regulations (GCR). In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Tournament Referee will be final. Alternate Service Laws will be applied for this tournament (BWF Statues, Section) 2. Tournament format will be a single knockout format for all events 3. The scoring system will be based on 1 match of 30 points except for semi-final and final. Meanwhile, the best of 3 games of 21 points scoring system will be applied for semi-final and final. 4. There shall be no replacement/substitution of players once the entries are submitted. However, the Organizing Committee, at its discretion, reserves the right to accept such changes if necessary and with valid reasons, so long as no match has been played by the player/s. For instant, the player in question unfortunately had contracted Chickenpox, hence we allow them to substitute the partner based on medical ground, so long as no match has been played. 5. All players must report to the waiting area at least 15 minutes prior to the scheduled time of their matches. 6. A grace period of maximum 5 minutes will be given for all matches. Failing which the player will concede a walkover for the particular match. 7. All players must bring along their photo identification documents for verification purposes at all times, failing which they might NOT be allowed to play. 8. Outcome for withdrawal, walkover and retire of matches. No appeal shall be entertained.

Situation	Definition	Outcome
Withdrawal before Draw	A player no longer taking part in the competition / a category before the start of the competition.	The player is allowed to participate in the other events.

Withdrawal after Draw	Please ensure that the tournament referee and the tournament organizer are notified immediately in writing or email, clearly stating the reason for withdrawal before the commencement of the tournament.	The player is NOT ALLOWED to participate in the other events.
Walkover	A player fails to turn up for their respective matches and concede a walkover. Opponent wins the match without having to compete.	The player whom concede a walkover shall no longer allowed to compete for other events in the rest of the tournament.
Retire	A player turns up for the match but stop taking part in the competition because of illness or injury. Opponent wins the match.	The player whom retire from an event shall no longer allowed to compete for all other events in the rest of the tournament.

9. All players are required to wear non-marking court shoes during the competition.
10. The tournament referee shall have the final decision on all technical and tournament matters. The organizing committee shall have the final decision on all administrative matters.
11. All doubles pairs are recommended to wear identical attire from the first day of competition. (i.e. identical colour and similar design throughout a match).
12. Players are required to stay on the court AFTER their match has ended, to act as line judges for the following match. Players who fail to do so may be disqualified from the competition. Players may also be called randomly to act as line judges for the 1st round of matches for the session. There shall be official line judges from Semi-Final onwards.
13. Any personnel who is taking the seat and performing the role of a coach must dress appropriately (sport clothing and covered shoe), no flip flop/sandals are allowed. The referee will decide if a coach is inappropriately dressed.
14. Only one coach is allowed per side regardless of singles or doubles.
15. The decision of the umpires and officials shall be deemed as final.
16. The order of play may change at the discretion of the Referee/ Organizer.
